In Luke 11:14-26 we find Jesus interacting with the religious leaders of his day around the subject of the spirit realm. Jesus affirms that there is a spirit reality that is seeking to influence the world in which we live. Throughout the text we discover a single truth coming to the surface ... Jesus is GREATER.

Sermon Outline:

Ephesians 6:12 "For we do not wrestle against **flesh and blood**"

Spirit (pneuma) breath, blast of air Key ideas:

- 1. God is spirit
- 2. We are spirit (living in a body)
- 3. There are other spirits (angels / demons)
- 4. * Spirits seek a physical body through which they can influence a physical world.

We should not <u>fear</u> what is **OUT THERE**. We should <u>guard</u> what gets **IN HERE**.

READ Luke 11:14

- Some physical, mental relationship, financial issues are spiritual in nature.
- We may misdiagnose the source ... Jesus never does.

Luke 11:17-20

- A divided kingdom will fall.
- Strength and weapons determine victory.

Jesus claims to be GREATER. That is why the evil spirits must obey!

Eph. 6:10 "be strong in the Lord and in the <u>strength of his might</u>. Put on the whole <u>armour of God</u>."

We do not battle evil in our strength, but with **His strength and weapons**.

Luke 11:24-26

- 1. It will <u>try</u> to come back
- 2. The way to remain free is to ensure there is no vacancy.

<u>Conclusion:</u> We do not live in fear of spirits out there; we seek to be constantly filled with His spirit so there is no room for anything else.

Suggested Discussion Questions:

Share a ghost story.

- Have you ever experienced the supernatural?
- Would you say that you live in fear of what is OUT THERE?
- Is it helpful to know that spirits seek physical bodies through which they can influence the world?
- In what ways do you think spirits influence us? How can we know which spirit is influencing us?
- Principle a divided kingdom will fall. How can you apply this principle to your life right now?

We do not battle evil in our strength, but with **His strength** and weapons.

• What are His weapons and how could they be used in your life right now (hint: Ephesians 6:10-20)

Jesus indicates that the evil spirit will try to come back.

 Have you seen or experienced this in your life or in the life of others?

Jesus also indicates that there is something that must be done after a person is set free. They must be filled with a better, stronger spirit.

• In what ways can we allow God's spirit and God's truth to permeate every part of our soul?
