4. In Nehemiah 3 we see individuals working on the wall right in front of their homes. What is right in front of you? What need is close by that you could do something about?
5. The wall of Jerusalem would provide a future for the community of people living in and around the city. In what ways could a church community be likened to the wall? In what ways might you contribute to our church community to help move the mission forward?
